as their new focus. **The Bridge Youth Resource Centre** offers support services for youth in the Leamington and surrounding area like daily hot meals, laundry and shower facilities, a clothing closet, a nutrition program and much more. The mission is to provide youth with hope for their future. We will all learn more about the work of **The Bridge** as the year progresses. Thanks for sharing to this worthy local cause.

#### **♦ Community Missions Announcement**

The Community Meals group is grateful for congregational support in providing baked goods for our monthly meals, as well as to those who plan, prepare, cook, and package the meals. We have been fortunate in having a consistently healthy balance in our Community Missions Account. When we first began, we prepared and served between 40 and 60 guests, and packaged around 20 take-out orders. Monthly meal costs usually totalled between \$200 and \$250. As you are aware, grocery costs have increased. As well, although we are not serving customers in the building, we now prepare and package 200 plus meals. The cost of a meal has risen to between \$450 and \$550. We are asking for donations to our Community Missions/Meals project, so that we can continue to fill this increasing need in our community.
