▶ NLUMC Council has been researching samples and pricing for aesthetic improvements to the **church's four washrooms:** paint, wallpaper, counter tops/sinks, taps, light fixtures, etc.

At this time, Church Council brings forward a recommendation to accept 'special donations' earmarked for the "Washroom Renovation Project." Once we have received 80% of the estimated \$8—10,000, we will then proceed, asking for volunteers to help in various ways. Sign-up sheets for people to assist this Spring with wallpaper removal, painting, minor construction, and minor electrical work, etc. will be made available so that we can keep the costs at a minimum.

Several suggestions for improved 'comfort height' toilets and new flooring for the washrooms have also been mentioned by several members. At this time, we do not have definitive plans but we are looking to see how the 'special donation funds' come in. *If members could kindly donate before April 16* so that Council can have further discussion at our monthly meeting on April 17, in order to bring recommendations forward at our April 21 membership meeting after church. Thanks for considering a donation by April 16 so that we have direction as to how to proceed on the washroom renovations.
