► NLUMC Council has been researching samples and pricing for aesthetic improvements to the **church's four washrooms:** paint, wallpaper, counter tops/sinks, taps, light fixtures, etc.

At this time, Church Council brings forward a recommendation to accept **'special donations'** earmarked for the "Washroom Renovation Project." Once we have received 80% of the estimated \$8—10,000, we will then proceed, asking for volunteers to help in various ways. Several suggestions for improved 'comfort height' toilets and new flooring for the washrooms have also been mentioned by several members. At this time, we do not have definitive plans but we are looking to see how the 'special donation funds' come in.
