#### ♦ News from the Missions Team

Here is something to consider: Palestinian Christians in Gaza and the West Bank have pleaded with North American Christians to speak out against the genocide, and the increased aggression against Palestinian lives in the West Bank. Mennonite Action is planning the following:

**Mennonite Action** is a movement of Mennonites bonded by a common belief that we must be public about our peace values. We believe that Mennonites have a responsibility to use our voices as powerfully as possible for the cause of peace and justice. We are taking public action as Mennonites. We are mobilizing Mennonites across the US and Canada to demand a ceasefire, end the US and western funded occupation of Palestine, and build for lasting peace.

**Mennonite Action** will hold our largest and most ambitious nonviolent mass mobilizations this July. <u>July 18-28</u>, we will march from Harrisonburg, VA to Washington, DC across a 10 day, 140 mile march. <u>July 28-30</u>, we will mobilize in Washington, DC for peace.

**Mennonite Action** is welcoming participation for either a day or for all 10 days for Mennonites and allies. They will be providing meals for all of the marchers, and have asked whether churches would consider donating funds for those costs. Likely none of us from our church will be participating personally, but perhaps an opportunity can be made for us to make a donation to Mennonite Action. Doing this does not preclude our actually physically participating in an action that might be happening in Ontario in the future. Mennonite Action has outlined the cost of the march and the mobilization in Washington and have suggested ways in which we can donate. These are opportunities to live out our anabaptist principles.
