The Leamington Community Hope Centre (LCHC) is participating in the **Coldest Night of the Year** fundraiser again this year and we are inviting

everyone to join the NLUMC Team, "We the North Church" to support this local organization providing much needed services in our community.

LCHC opened in January 2023 as a drop-in program for those experiencing homelessness and hardships of any kind. Since then, they have been offering a hot meal daily (even weekends and holidays) from 6-10 pm, currently serving between 70 to 100 people each night. They also provide addictions counselling and support, AA, NA, and Al-Anon programs, and Hope Church, a weekly worship service on Tuesday evenings. In the past year they have opened two recovery homes, one for men and one for women.

We are inviting you to join our team - We the North Church and walk with us on **Saturday**, **February 22**.

Last year we raised \$1230 with 12 walkers and 18 contributors! Can we beat these numbers in 2025? We think we can! Our goal this year is set for \$1500. Let's exceed this goal!
