♦ Leamington Mennonite Home News

The Leamington Mennonite Home continues to be grateful for the continued financial support received from the supporting congregations. Last year we used donations received from the churches to paint and replace the flooring and lighting in the Pickwick Apartments. As the Home continues to refurbish the Pickwick Apartments this year, the donations received from the churches will be used toward the continued renovation of all apartment units as they become available. The Pickwick Apartments were built in 1979 and aside from minor improvements these units remain almost original from the time they were built. To date, this has included concrete pads and privacy fences for the first floor residents, complete refurbishment of all common spaces and laundry facilities, an awning for the north entrance, replacement of the building's fresh air exchange, replacing electric baseboard heating with more efficient heat pumps, renovation of each unit to include an open concept design, replacing tubs with walk in showers, and finally to new building security using facial recognition to gain access into the building coming soon. Overall, this building will remain an affordable option for seniors in our community.

♦ Local Foodgrains Bank Update. Many thanks to all that support the effort to promote the Canadian Foodgrains Bank. All together with the Rollkuchen event, the Fall harvest meal and our local growing projects we were able to send a total of \$65,910 to Winnipeg through the MCC for the 2024 year. We trust that these funds will be multiplied by our government in an effort to end world hunger. Thanks and blessings to all of you!
