### **♦** Emergency First Aid

On **Sunday, November 30**, at 11:15 am, we will take approximately fifteen minutes for ushers, nurses, first aid people, and any other interested persons to meet at the usher's desk and we will look at our defibrillator to acquaint ourselves with the equipment. We have many registered nurses who are always willing and prepared to assist as needed in case of medical emergency, and this Fall we also had six members become certified in emergency first aid. The church has two first aid kits - one is found in the middle of the kitchen beside the stove, clearly labelled with the red/white first aid sign; and the second kit is at the usher's table at the back of the sanctuary. We always hope that we do not need to use these resources and we pray for everyone's health and safety.

The Pastor-Congregation Relations Committee is a supportive and confidential group dedicated to strengthening the relationship between the pastor and the congregation.
