Youth Program Update and Survey

Over the summer months, the Ministry Team considered the input from the Youth meeting held last April. Ministry Team issued a survey in September to gather additional input from the broader congregation to support programming for Youth. Thank you to everyone who completed the survey.

At the September Church Council meeting, a proposal of the Ministry Team to create a part time Youth Leader position was discussed. It was determined that a Youth Team be established to provide coordination and support to the Youth Program.

The Nominations Team reached out to fill the three positions in early October. The membership of this newly formed team includes Pastor Charleen, Mandi Scherer-Horne and Joanne Brown.

The North Nights Junior Youth program began in October with the Baking and Bible Stories series under the leadership of Pastor Charleen with support from Pastor Kendall and Pastor Ken. Held weekly on Saturday evenings from 6:30 to 8 pm between October 26 and November 23, a number of volunteers participated in baking activities with our Junior Youth. Junior Youth also participated in the Leamington Christmas Parade.

The Fall program ended with the Youth (both Junior and Senior) Christmas Party on Saturday, December 7.

Some observations from our fall experience:

- The Youth Team is not adequately resourced.

- A Youth Leader/Coordinator position is necessary to support success of the program and so we are again considering the proposal presented by Ministry Team.

The Youth Team is issuing a survey to gather feedback and input regarding:

- the North Nights Junior Youth Baking and Bible Stories series.
- program planning for 2020.
- the development of the role of Youth Leader/Coordinator.
- seeking volunteer support from the congregation for the Youth Team.
