#### **♦ Church Council News**

Church Council wants to address the news that the Ontario government is allowing limited in person worship in church buildings. At this point we do not anticipate worshipping in our church building this summer. Because the limitations are so understandably stringent (a limit of a third of building capacity, no congregational singing, children required to be with their parents at all times, no possibility of coffee time conversations, physical distancing in and between pews, considerable additional cleaning) the risks, particularly for our vulnerable members, seem to outweigh the benefits at this time. Just because we are allowed to gather to worship doesn't mean we should. We will continue to worship online as Church Council monitors this situation moving forward.

The church building is now closed. The church secretary, Susan Klassen, is now working from home. If you have any questions, please call the church office, 519-326-7928 and leave a message. The phone messages are checked daily. Canada Post mail is picked up regularly. Emails are checked daily. The bulletin should be available online on Friday afternoon. The pastors are also working from home.
