This tradition is called the Stations of the Cross, or the Way of the Cross. The stations of this journey will be easy for you to find - a spout or flowing water, a heavy log or rock, a quiet place to sit, a flower, a tree leaning against another tree.... The guide comes with scripture references, prayers - simplified for the kids' version, with wondering questions. Though we are apart, we can do this "together".
