♦ Youth Ministry Update

Over the past 2+ years, NLUMC has done a lot of data gathering and discernment with respect to youth ministry. Ministry Team had a significant focus on youth for close to two years. Pastor Alicia prepared and delivered a focus group/workshop in April 2019, Ministry Team gathered data through a survey in August/September that year. A Youth Team was created and a second survey was completed in December/January 2020. Survey results were shared with the congregation at the 2020 AGM and the pastors (Ken Driedger, Charleen and Kendall) completed the Youth Listening Project, interviewing 21 families of youth in the spring of 2020. We have collected a lot of information!

\$10,000 was set aside for a youth leader/pastor position in 2020 and continues to be part of the approved NLUMC budget for 2021.

Advice from MCEC is that other churches have been most successful when sharing job postings within their congregation and the local community.
