

▶ **SECC Fundraiser.** This is the final day for collecting grocery gift cards (\$25 or \$50 preferred) for SECC needs, wants and book fundraiser for families in our community in need. ▶ Community Meals. Once a month our church provides a meal for those in need in our community through the St. John's Anglican Church. We are coming to the end of our 2021 Community Meals commitment. Due to COVID restrictions, we have been unable to participate on site. Our current commitment has been the transfer of \$300 per month. Unfortunately, our budget will be depleted following our November transfer and we will need to fundraise in order to keep our ongoing commitment. Due to the rising cost of groceries, as well as increasing need, we are suggesting that we fundraise with a goal of \$5000 for 2022.
