♦ Learning Opportunities

Throughout the month of May, each of our North Church pastors will be leading a learning opportunity to help us grow deeper in our faith. You get to choose which one best suits your needs and interests!

- 1. Pastor Alicia will lead a social media-based group around listening to a podcast called The Liturgist. This group will invite folks to listen each week to a one-hour podcast and share their reflections together through social media. Warning: these podcasts are bound to spark some debate, questions, and critical thinking! Weekly time commitment: About one hour to listen to the podcast, plus 15 minutes to engage with online responses.
- 2. NEW! Bible Study Thursdays at 10:30 am, May 6-June 10 (6 weeks). Led by Pastor Charleen, on Zoom. This study will help us engage in stories of Courageous Women in the Bible journeying along with the topic of our sermon series. Open to men and women.

 From Pastor Charleen As a girl, I loved discovering the stories of women in the Bible I read and reread Esther and Ruth (they were easy to find, and it took approximately one sermon to read each book). I was disgusted by Jael putting the tent peg through that general's head. I was inspired by Deborah, who was a judge in her own right. I liked Miriam, Moses' sister, dancing with her tambourines. I was intrigued by all the Mary's in the New Testament. But most of all, I was hungry to hear the good news that the gospel story was not just for and about men, but that it included me. In this study we will engage with the stories of well-known women of the Bible, and some of the lesser-known ones. Stories of courage, pain, and redemption.
- 3. You are invited to a Book Study Discussion group on **Thursday evenings at 7 starting on May 6.** Notice the **Change of book!** I, Pastor Kendall, have become convinced through reading a variety of reviews that my choice of *White Fragility* is not appropriate for this discussion group, so I am changing the book. Instead, we will discuss *I'm Still Here: Black Dignity in a World Made for Whiteness* by Austin Channing Brown.
